- Any media can be used. No computer generated art or computer generated printing. All work must be original by the artist/patient.
- The theme is "October is National Orthodontic Health Month". These words should be used on the poster. The poster should reflect the theme. All words must be spelled correctly. The poster must be complete!
- Your name should be printed clearly in the lower right hand corner on the front of the poster.
- Entries must be created on posterboard furnished by this office. It does not matter which way the posterboard is turned (vertical or horizontal).

Judging will be completed by staff at our office. Judges will be looking for the OVERALL IMPACT for the winning poster. Remember, the poster MUST portray the theme. The decisions of the judges are final.

When your poster is complete, fill out the sheet below and cut on the line. Securely tape information to the back of your poster. Deadline to turn in posters is Thursday, September 16 at 4:00. Return posters to reception staff at front office. One winner will be chosen for each group. One winner from each group will receive \$25.00.
